was founded to build new homes for orphans around the world. **REACH** has partnered up with Lawrence Technological University (LTU) in Southfield, MI to assist **PWOJE ESPWA SUD (ESPWA)**, a Haitian registered NGO that cares for approximately 680 orphaned children and provides primary, secondary and vocational training for 1,200 students in Les Cayes, Haiti. It is run by Father Marc Boisvert, a Catholic priest and former Navy Chaplain. **ESPWA** is in dire need of 2 new homes to house a group of maturing girls.

REACH is looking for 15 volunteers to travel to help build these new homes. No construction experience is needed. Everyone can have a productive and positive experience. Must be 18 years of old at date of departure or accompanied by a parent or guardian. Parents & Guests 1are welcomed. If interested please contact us and submit application by December 15, '09.
